

Norwin Soccer Club In-House Tournament Rules Co-ed U11-18

1. Games will be two 12-minute halves with a 2 – minute halftime.
2. Play will be round robin as determined by the number in the age group.
3. Points will be awarded as follows:
 - Win – 3
 - Tie – 1
 - Loss – 0

4. In the event of ties at the end of round robin play, the following tie breakers will be used to determine playoff:
 - A. Head to head competition. (only used in a 2-way tie)
 - B. Least losses.
 - C. Most goals scored. (maximum of 4 per game)
 - D. Least goals allowed.
 - E. Most games scoring 2 or more goals.
 - F. Most games scoring 3 or more goals.
 - G. Most shutouts.
 - H. Least times team was shutout.
 - I. Least number of penalty cards. (red or yellow)
 - J. One 5 minute overtime period without goalkeepers.
 - K. Successive 5 minutes overtime periods with one less player than the previous period, minimum two players per team. Upon reaching three players on the field per team there is no offsides.

Note: If two teams are tied for seeding position only after tiebreaker 4I., the tie will be broken with a coin toss.

5. Playoffs will be single elimination.
6. In the event of a tie in a playoff game, tiebreaker 4J through 4K will be used.
7. The referee will be the official scorekeeper.
8. First team, as shown on the schedule, will have choice of the ball or goal at the start of the game.
9. The winning coach is responsible to deliver the score card, filled out by the referee, to the Soccer Club building immediately after the game. In case of a tie one of the coaches must deliver the card.
10. All regular season rules apply in the tournament. **This includes each player must play ½ of each game.** Penalty for not playing all players ½ of each game is a coach ejection. No players may be added to a team during the tournament. Teams are only permitted to play with their regular rosters. Teams must play with an equal number of players on the field.
11. Except as noted, FIFA and Norwin Soccer Club regular season in-house rules will apply.
12. All kickoffs are indirect.
13. A player committing an intentional handball foul during an overtime period will be ejected from that game and the team will play one player short for the remainder of the game. If this occurs when there are two players on a team, the game is over and the opponent wins.
14. **There will be no penalty kicks during the tournament.** Kick will be taken from the point of the foul. Wall is permitted.
15. Only **2 coaches per team (U8, U10, U12 and U14)** allowed on touchline (sideline) and no parents/coaches behind goals.
